■ Course Outline

The UNIDO Compressed Air System Optimisation (CASO) end user course will be Livestreamed over 3-day/ 5 hr/day. Gain a comprehension of, and technical capacity to initiate the development and implementation of CASO measures into new and existing systems. Candidates will be able to identify potential optimisation opportunities, and determine how to achieve cost savings and energy efficiency through the appropriate application of CASO. Completing this training, and passing the required test, could result in a candidate qualifying for the UNIDO CASO Expert Level training.

The expert course equips candidates with the knowledge, skills and tools needed to support the adoption and implementation of CASO in industry by technically assisting enterprises and coaching facility personnel on CASO project development and implementation. (Note expert level is done on-site only).
